

Richard Cantor serves as Chief Risk Officer for Moody's Corporation, and Chief Credit Officer for Moody's Investors Service. Mr. Cantor was appointed Chief Risk Officer in 2009 and in this role leads the firm's global risk management function. As Chief Credit Officer, a position he has held since 2008, Dr. Cantor leads the Credit Strategy and Standards Group, which is responsible for ratings strategy, process oversight, cross-sector research, methodologies, models, and technology tools.

Prior to joining Moody's in 1997, Mr. Cantor held a variety of positions at the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, including in the Capital Markets Group and the Discount Window, and was an adjunct professor at New York University's and Columbia University's business schools. He has also taught Economics at UCLA and Ohio State Universities. Mr. Cantor holds BA degrees
