

Bernardo Larraín Matte is President of The Federation of Chilean Industry (SOFOFA). Previously, he was a member of the Council of SOFOFA, a private, non-profit trade and Chile's largest business association.

Mr. Larraín is a Member of the Board of Colbún S.A. From 2012 to 2017, Mr. Larraín occupied the position of Chairman of the Board, and was Chief Executive Officer from 2005 to 2012.
