

Joanne de Asis is Chairperson of Globe Capital Partners LLC, a financial advisory and investment company engaged in cross-border strategic alliances and investments since 1997. She is also Senior Advisor to Morgan Stanley where she started her career in 1977 in New York and worked up the corporate ladder in New York and London.

Ms. de Asis sits on several local and international boards, including IISS in London; Annenberg Foundation at Sunnylands in California; Walton's Crystal Bridges in Arkansas; and recently, Aboitiz Equity Ventures. In 2022, she was appointed by President Ferdinand Marcos Jr. as member of the Private Sector Advisory Council.

After a successful career abroad, she opened the representative office for Morgan Stanley in the Philippines where she is actively involved in cross-border mergers and acquisitions. These "under-the-radar" deals include Philippine Del Monte purchase of Del Monte USA, and the largest investment into a Philippine institution (Security Bank) by a foreign bank (BTMU). She closed one of the largest power deals, selling 100% of AEF at USD2.4 billion to San Miguel Power, and more recently, in a record of three months, a USD550 million sale of Gold Coin to Aboitiz's Pilmico group.

Ms. de Asis finished her MBA (with honors) from Columbia University, and holds a Bachelor's degree, major in Communication Arts, from Maryknoll College in the Philippines. She completed the Stanford University Executive Program in Palo Alto in 1999.
