

Kyung Shik Sohn is Chairman of the Korea Enterprises Federation (KEF), an organization that is dedicated to building industrial peace and improving national competitiveness through labor-management cooperation and economic growth. Having demonstrated great leadership and expertise throughout his career, Mr. Sohn has been invited and assumed various roles to represent as well as serve the business community, both domestically and internationally.
