KOVA was established in 1995 to spread entrepreneurship and to improve the venture-startup environment. In February 2021, Mr. Kang was elected as Chairman of the Korea Venture Business Association (KOVA) to support the venture-startup-related system and policy. He also serves as a member of the government's SME Council as well as the Presidential Committee on Jobs and the Special Regulatory Free Zone.

Point Mobile is one of the fastest growing manufacturer of handheld devices in the world. Since 2006, it has produced a variety of devices for retail, logistics, field services, health care, and many other industries. From 2013, Point Mobile's brand of devices was introduced, offering a full range of handheld mobile computers, rugged smartphones, LTE/Android integrated mobile payment devices, healthcare terminals, RFID readers, and portable Bluetooth scanners. Point Mobile is now the #1 manufacturer of handheld devices in Korea, having captured a 30 percent share of the domestic market.

Mr. Kang received the Prime Minister's commendation from the Korean government in 2016 and the Presidential commendation for Venture Startup Development in 2020.
