

Maria Olivia Recart is Director of Lundin Mining Corporation. She has held various positions in non-profit, public and private sectors, including in higher education. She participates in the International Women's Forum (IWF), is an Aspen Fellow and Member of the Board of Comunidad Mujer, a non-profit organization with advocacy on issues related to women. She was Vice President of the Board of Fundación Chile (innovation), Fundación Escondida (social topics) and CEIM (skills training center). She was a non-executive member of the Board of CAP, a diversified conglomerate with activities in mining (iron ore), refinery and distribution of products (steel) in Chile, Perú and Argentina.

From 2019 to 2023, Mrs. Recart was President of Universidad Santo Tomás, a private university with more than 30 years of history, eight faculties and 28 thousand students in 13 cities of Chile where more than 60% are first generation in higher education.

Mrs. Recart was a member of the executive team of BHP (Australian mining company) in the Americas for eight years overseeing activities in South and North America. She also served two periods in government, with four years as Vice Minister of Finance for Chile (2006-2010), and led the team that brought Chile into the OECD.
