Mr. Kamezaki started his career at Mitsubishi Corporation in 1966. For over 40 years, he has been deeply engaged in developing the regional corporate strategy as well as managing the more than 200 offices worldwide of Mitsubishi Corporation. He has extensive experience overseas including as General Manager in East Berlin in the late 1970s; Executive Vice President of Mitsubishi International Corporation in New York in the late 1990s; and President of Mitsubishi Corporation (Taiwan) Ltd. in Chinese Taipei in 2000. In 2002, he assumed the post of Executive Vice President and Chief Regional Officer of Mitsubishi Corporation. In 2005, he was promoted to Senior Executive Vice President and engaged in Corporate Planning and Regional Strategy.

In 2007, Mr. Kamezaki was appointed by the Japanese Government as a Member of the Policy Board of the Bank of Japan. For five years, he has been focused entirely on deciding the monetary policy of Japan as one of the nine board members in the midst of turbulent times.
