



Rod Eddington, AO, is Chairman of JP Morgan's Asia-Pacific Advisory Council and non-executive Chairman of Lion. Sir Rod was educated as an engineer at the University of Western Australia (UWA) and then Oxford University as WA's 1974 Rhodes Scholar. Sir Rod's career began in transport and aviation and he went on to become CEO of Cathay Pacific, Ansett Airlines and British Airways, before retiring in late 2005 and returning to Australia.

In 2005, Sir Rod was awarded a *Knighthood* by the British Government for service to civil aviation, in 2012, an *Officer of the Order of Australia* (AO) for service to business and commerce and in 2015, the *Grand Cordon of the Order of the Rising Sun* for his contribution to strengthening the economic relations between Japan and Australia.

In addition to maintaining non-executive directorships with China Light & Power Holdings, John Swire & Sons and The Herald & Weekly Times, Sir Rod also serves as Chairman of Infrastructure Partnerships Australia and is President of the Australia-Japan Business Cooperation Committee.
