Prior to joining ABAC, Jeramie had five years of solid experience working for the Philippine Government. She worked at the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) as Technical Assistant to the Philippine Senior Official for the Brunei-Indonesia-Malaysia-Philippines East ASEAN Growth Area (BIMP-EAGA). She also provided technical support to the Undersecretary on the ASEAN/APEC Integration-Specific Initiative on SME Trade Facilitation. Her work involved drafting of position papers, conducting researches and coordination with in-country and international stakeholders. She also had the opportunity to participate in international conferences such as the ASEAN Summit and BIMP-EAGA Summit in Kuala Lumpur and Langkawi, Malaysia respectively.

Her keen interest in security issues and passion for humanitarian work were further developed when she worked as Program Officer at the Office of the Presidential Adviser on the Peace Process (OPAPP), the government agency mandated to implement the comprehensive peace process.
