



Yongmaan Park is Chairman of Doosan Business Research Institute.

As a strategic drive to overhaul Doosan's business portfolio mainly comprised of consumer goods, Mr. Park led over 42 deals including acquisitions and divestitures, thereby turning Doosan into an Infrastructure Support Business (ISB)-centered enterprise. The acquisition of Bobcat, the world leader in compact construction equipment, was also part of the portfolio shift. He has also spearheaded Doosan's broader globalization efforts transforming a domestic company into a multinational conglomerate with operations in 38 countries and over 50 percent of its 42,000 employees working overseas.

Acknowledged for his leadership and expertise, Mr. Park was elected Chairman of the Korea Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KCCI) in August 2013. Moreover, he has served as executive member of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC) since June 2014. He has played a key role in representing diverse voices of businesses and building close partnerships between the private and public sectors, both domestically and globally.

Mr. Park received a *Commander of the Order of the Star* from the Italian government in 2016, the *Van Fleet Award* from the Korea Society in 2014, and *Gold Tower Industry Award* from the Korean government in 2012.

Mr. Park holds a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from Seoul National University and a Master of Business Administration degree from Boston University.
