



Sergio Ley Lopez is Executive Vice President and Asia-Pacific Chairman of the Mexican Business Council for Foreign Trade, Investment and Technology (COMCE).

He joined the Mexican Foreign Service in 1984 and assumed various positions including as: Cultural Counselor to Mexican Embassy in Beijing, China from September 1984 to July 1990; Deputy Chief of Mission of Embassy of Mexico in Singapore from July 1990 to August 1993; Consul General in Shanghai, China from August 1993 to January 1995; and Director General for Pacific and Asia at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs from January 1995 to March 1997. He was Mexico's Ambassador to Indonesia from March 1997 to November 2001 and to the People's Republic of China

from November 2001 to January 2007. He was appointed Honorary Consul of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka in June 2011.

He received the Award of the Chancellor of Japan in 2019 and the *Decoration of the Order of the Rising Sun, in the degree of Golden Rays with Hanging Ribbon* in 2021 for his career and contributions in strengthening business ties and economic cooperation.

He earned a degree in Architecture from the National Autonomous University of Mexico, pursued postgraduate studies in Art History at the University of Paris, France and obtained a Diploma on Restoration of Historical Buildings from the Institute of Archaeology of the London University in Great Britain.
