

Sergio Ley López is Partner and Member of the Board of Grupo Ley, which includes companies such as Casa Ley S.A.P.I. de C.V., Del Campo y Asociados S.A. de C.V., Promotora de Deportes y Espectáculos S.A. de C.V., among others.

From 2007 until December 2024, he served as Executive Vice President and Asia-Pacific Chairman of the Mexican Business Council for Foreign Trade, Investment and Technology (COMCE), where he actively promoted Mexico's economic engagement with the Asia-Pacific region. He was also Member of the Board of the Institute of the Americas, UCSD, from 2008 to 2017.

He joined the Mexican Foreign Service in 1984, holding senior diplomatic posts including: Cultural Counselor at the Embassy of Mexico in Beijing (1984-1990); Deputy Chief of Mission in Singapore (1990-1993); Consul General in Shanghai (1993-1995); and Director General for Pacific and Asia at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (1995-1997). He later served as Ambassador of Mexico to Indonesia (1997-2001) and to the People's Republic of China (2001-2007). From 2011 to 2024, he also served as Honorary Consul of Sri Lanka in Mexico.

Ambassador Ley has received international recognition, including the *Chancellor's Award of Japan* (2019) and the *Order of the Rising Sun, Golden Rays with Neck Ribbon* (2021), for his contributions to strengthening business ties and economic cooperation.

He holds a degree in Architecture from the National Autonomous University of Mexico, postgraduate studies in Art History from the University of Paris, and a Diploma in Restoration of Historical Buildings from the University of London.
