



Hyunghee Lee is Vice Chairman of the Korea Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KCCI). He plays a key role in advocating a wide range of businesses to the government and encouraging members to pursue environmental, social and governance (ESG) values.

Since 2023, he has served as President of SK SUPEX Council's Communication Committee. The Council is the top advisory group within SK, setting strategic direction and providing guidance.
