

Jun Suzuki has served as Senior Advisor of Teijin Limited since June 2023. Previously, he was the President & CEO of Teijin Limited from 2014 to 2022, leading the company's business operations throughout the Americas, Europe and Asia. Since joining the company as a research scientist in 1983, he held a range of senior positions in both material and healthcare businesses, continuously being a dedicated driving force behind the company's efforts to leverage the power of both material and healthcare knowledge for addressing myriad global challenges.

Dr. Suzuki has held several senior business and economic roles, including Vice Chairman of the Japan Association of Corporate Executives (KEIZAI DOYUKAI), Chairman of the Committee on Geopolitical Risks (KEIZAI DOYUKAI), Executive Member of the Policy Board of the Japan Business Federation (Keidanren), Chairman of Japan-Thailand Trade and Economic Committee (Keidanren), and Member of Japan-US Business Council. Most recently, he was appointed as Executive Member of the Council for Science, Technology Innovation (CSTI) of the Government of Japan in March 2025.
