



Alfred Landon Loomis, appointed President of Boeing China in October 2025 and based in Beijing, leads the company's operations, strategy, partnerships, and senior government relationships in China while retaining his role as Vice President for Global Policy, coordinating government affairs and geopolitical analysis to support international sales and growth.

He joined Boeing in September 2019 from the White House, where he was a special adviser to Vice President Mike Pence, and subsequently served as President and CEO for Boeing in Latin America, the Caribbean, and Brazil. Mr. Loomis's prior U.S. government roles include policy adviser at the Office of the U.S. Trade Representative and commercial attaché in Beijing and Brasília; he has lived and worked in 10 countries across Latin America, Asia, and Eastern Europe.

He holds a master's degree in international economics and speaks English, Mandarin, Portuguese, and Spanish.
