



Phacharaphot Nuntramas is Executive Vice President and Chief Economist of Krungthai Bank PCL, where he leads the Bank's economic research and analysis function and established Krungthai COMPASS, the Bank's research unit. In this role, Dr. Nuntramas provides economic insights and strategic analysis to support business decision-making and broader financial sector development. He also serves as a member of the Bank's Sustainability Management Committee, contributing to the integration of sustainability perspectives into the Bank's strategic direction.

Dr. Nuntramas is active in the broader economic and financial community. He has served as Chair of the Economist Analyst's Club under the Thai Bankers' Association since 2020. He also plays an active role in analyzing and reporting on Thailand's economic conditions to the Joint Standing Committee on Commerce, Industry and Banking (JSCCIB), supporting private sector discussions on key economic and financial developments.

Prior to his current role at Krungthai Bank, Dr. Nuntramas served as Head of Economic and Financial Market Research at the Economic Intelligence Center of Siam Commercial Bank PCL. He holds a Ph.D. and M.A. in Economics from the University of Michigan, USA, and a B.A. in Economics with First Class Honors from Thammasat University.
