



Ho Sy Hung is Chairman and President of the Vietnam Chamber of Commerce and Industry (VCCI), the domestic organization representing the Vietnamese business community and employers. He assumed the position of President of VCCI on 14 November 2025.

Dr. Hung has more than 30 years of experience in economic management and public administration. Before joining VCCI, he served as Vice Minister of Finance, responsible for public financial management, accounting and auditing, legal affairs, and capacity building.
