



Anindya Novyan Bakrie is an Indonesian business magnate, global investor, and philanthropist who has long represented Indonesia and the Indo-Pacific business community in international fora. He is the CEO of Bakrie & Brothers (BNBR), a listed conglomerate with diversified interests spanning infrastructure, electric vehicles, mining, oil and gas, power (including renewables), property, and plantations. As successor to the 83-year-old Bakrie Group, one of Indonesia's largest business groups with 12 companies listed on the Indonesia Stock Exchange, he is leading its pivot toward sustainable and digital investments in electric vehicles, batteries, solar energy, prefab housing, fintech, and other emerging technologies.

In September 2024, Mr. Bakrie was elected Chairman of the Indonesian Chamber of Commerce and Industry (KADIN) for the 2024-2029 term, representing over 100,000 businesses nationwide. He also chairs ASEAN-BAC Indonesia, and recently joined the B20 South Africa IBAC, reinforcing Indonesia's role in regional and South-South cooperation. Under his leadership, ABAC Indonesia launched the Indonesia Impact Fund.

Beyond business, he has been a Director of Oxford United Football Club since 2018, leading its majority acquisition and promotion to the Championship in 2024. He holds an Industrial Engineering degree from Northwestern University and an MBA from Stanford University.
