

Dang Thanh Tam is Chairman of Saigon Invest Group (SGI), one of the leading groups in Viet Nam which has uniquely received 18 leading flags for best contribution from the government since 2000. It is also one of Viet Nam's leading private conglomerates with a portfolio of more than 50 companies across diverse sectors and two publicly-listed firms: KinhBacCity (KBC), and SaigonTel (SGT). Among them, KBC stands out as Viet Nam's leading developer of industrial parks, urban areas, and social housing, accounting for up to 15% of its annual foreign direct investment (FDI). SGI is also recognized as a Global Growth Companies (GGC) member of the World Economic Forum (WEF), representing Viet Nam on the global stage.

He was a Member of Viet Nam's National Assembly and its Foreign Affairs Committee (2011-2016), Co-Chairman of the Viet Nam-Japan Economic Forum (VJEF), and remains an active member of the Young Presidents' Organization (YPO-WPO), the Chief Executives Organization (CEO), and Chairman of the Viet Nam Golden Star Club.

He is the first private entrepreneur in Viet Nam to be awarded the *First, Second, and Third Class Labor Medals* by the President, six *Certificates of Merit* from the Prime Minister, and the first Vietnamese businessman honored with a *Commendation* by the Government of Japan. Academically, he holds degrees in Maritime Studies, Business Administration, and Law, as well as a Business Management Diploma from Henley Management College, United Kingdom.
